The Rye Racing 2011 Winter 12 Car Rally Series

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Announcement.

The Eastbourne and Ram Motor Club Ltd will run a clubsport permit 12 car navigational rally series consisting of events on the following dates 28/11/10, 19/12/10, 09/01/11, 30/01/11, 20/02/11 and 13/03/11.

The meetings will be governed by the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the international Sporting Code of the FIA), by these Supplementary Regulations and by any other written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

2. Eligibility.

Registration will be automatic upon joining the club and subsequent payment and/or renewal of membership fees or may be subject to a championship registration fee.

3. Classes.

Two classes: Expert & Novice.

A Novice is defined as any club member who has not previously won a competitive navigational rally other than team or marque award with Eastbourne & Ram Motor Club or any MSA affiliated club prior to the beginning of the championship year.

A novice navigator may team up with an expert driver and still be classed as a novice.

The Championship winning Novice crew will be upgraded to expert at the end of the Championship year.

4. Points.

14 points - 1st place, 12 points - 2nd place, 11 points - 3rd place - reducing by one point one place down to 2 points for 12th place.

Non finishers to receive 2 points.

Organisers – 11 points per event organised – maximum of two events.

Championship Contenders – 11 points per event – maximum of two events.

5. Navigation.

Experts : Navigation can be of any format (Complete route may be given out at the Start or may be on the plot and bash basis).

Novices : Simplified easy navigation (Marked Maps or Semi-Marked Maps or all tulip, pre-plot etc) so that they can concentrate on map reading and timing which should then encourage novices and newcomers to participate in navigational rallies.

- 6.** Entry Fee per round to be £10.00.
Lockton Insurance fee (if required) £16.28 [Nov 2009]

7. Awards.

These will be presented to first Expert crew and First Novice crew after each event subject to three entries in either class.

Final Championship awards to be presented for 1st placed overall driver and navigator also 1st place novice driver and navigator at the Annual Dinner Dance.
